Tuition

Tuition is automatically charged to the card on file on the first business day of each month.

Failed Payments: Payments that fail to go through will incur a \$15 fee, first time offenses will receive a one-time courtesy waiver.

Mandatory Class Dress Code



PRE-K AGES 2 - 5:

- Leotards: Any leotard is acceptable in class. However, please note; a black camisole or black tank leotard will be required for the Winter Class Showings in December.

Footless Tights or Leggings: If dancers are dancing without ballet slippers, their feet need to be *uncovered*. Tights that are *footless* (come to the ankle) or *convertible* (have a slit in the bottom of the sole to pull the foot through) are recommended.



No Shoes Required: Ballet slippers are not required; however, they are welcome in class.

Hair: Pulled securely out of the face. Please limit hair accessories.

Boys: Fairly form-fitting sweat bottoms and t-shirts. No socks, no shoes.

KINDERGARTEN - TEEN*

- Leotards: Solid-black camisole or tank leotard (reference photos above).



- Tights: Light pink ballet tights, footed or convertible.

- Slippers: Light pink, split sole, canvas ballet slippers. Please purchase name brands (such as Block or Capezio).

- Hair: Tight bun. Please use bobby pins and hairnets. Where buns are not reasonable due to hair length or texture, please ensure the hair is pulled out of the face and secured as best as possible.

Boys: Fairly form-fitting sweat bottoms and t-shirts. No socks. Black canvas ballet slipper (most all slippers are unisex).

*TEENS: Additionally need to bring a pair of black leggings or form fitting sweats that can be worn over tights. All tights must be of the convertible variety.

Tech Classes:

Tech 1, 2 & 3 can wear any color of leotard for their tech class only until class leotards have been purchased (mid to late September). Your account will be charged \$25.00 at this time- measurements and purchasing will be done for you.

Contemporary tech classes can wear black socks or bare feet. Solid-colored, tight-fitting leggings are encouraged, rather than tights. Dancers may wear leotards or form fitting, solid colored tops.

The “Why” behind the “Wear”:

We ask that you help your dancer maintain the dress code. It will benefit them in the following ways:

1. If you look the part, you act the part.
2. Limits distraction.
3. Helps students and teachers see and create lines, posture and proper technique within the body.

Spring 2024 Performance

Mark your calendars for May 17th (mandatory rehearsal) and 18th (performance date). We will deliver more information as we get closer. You will not want to miss this event!

The Dance Box alternates each year between:

1. **Full Studio Performance**

- Entire studio involved in a full show with a common theme
- hosted at a large-scale venue and on a professional stage
- costume purchase to keep
- mandatory dress rehearsal

2. **Class Performances**

- An intimate setting with focus on individual classes
- held at a smaller local venue
- costume rental

This year we will be participating in a **Full Studio Performance format** at the Capitol Theater in downtown Salt Lake City.

We are so excited for the sweet memories & meaningful experience this performance is going to offer our students & their families! Students get the experience of being in a professional production in collaboration with many other performers. This is an important learning experience within dance as a performance-based art.

Performance & Photography Fee

This will be charged to each student's account at the beginning of March. It includes:

- Dress rehearsal participation at Capitol Theater
- Performance participation at Capitol Theater
- Professional portrait photography session & all edited images
- At least two comp tickets per household.

Fees also help cover all production staff, lighting equipment rentals & staff, sound equipment & staff, props, venue rental costs, etc.

The fee is \$115/student or \$200/family. There is no additional expense for technique program classes; a costume rental will be provided.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Performance fees are waived for volunteers. If you or a family member age 21+ would like to be a performance support volunteer for the day of dress rehearsal or performance (there will be two performances- dancers will only perform in one of the two), please email us at creativedancebox@gmail.com.

COSTUME PURCHASE

This year, students get to keep their costume! These become the sweetest keepsakes that can be passed on for many years of dressing up to come.

Costume purchases will be **charged to your account along with tuition on the first business day of January**. We have to order costumes many months ahead of time in order for them to arrive on schedule. The costume purchase is as follows:
