Performance Format

Each year we alternate between

1. **Full Studio Show** at a large venue with a costume purchase
2. **Class Performances** at a smaller local venue with a costume rental

This year we will be engaging in a **Class Performance** format. This format offers opportunities to hyper-focus on each student & provide them with more in-depth opportunities to showcase their own work.

Performance & Photography Fee

\$65/dancer will be charged to your account at the beginning of March. This covers:

- Participation in class performance
- Costume rental
- Photo keepsake
- Costumed photo session & professionally edited gallery
- **Free admission** for you & an unlimited number of guests.

Spring Photography Schedule

Photos are taken outside. If weather is an issue, we will text & email before class and will postpone to the following week.

All **parents of dancers Kindergarten & younger are asked to stay** to dress and undress their dancer in their costumes & assist them to and from class when it is their turn to be photographed.

Performance Notes

Hair & Makeup

Dancers need to have their hair and makeup done **before** arriving.

Performance Hair

Girls: Slicked tightly into a ballet bun- no flyaways. Where hair texture and length do not allow for a bun- please find the best suitable way to pull cleanly out of the face. No extra hair accessories such as bows & headbands where possible.

Boys: Cleanly styled.

Performance Makeup

Note: Please be ENORMOUSLY careful when putting costumes on so as not to transfer makeup onto costumes. No dark or bright lip colors please- these tend to destroy our costumes (and most of our costumes are white this year).

Ages 2 - 6 makeup: Whatever amount you and your dancer feel comfortable with, though please keep it minimal.

Ages 7+ makeup: Natural colors; mascara, blush, light-neutral eye shadow, & natural lip color.

Performance Wear

Costumes will be available in the green room upon arrival and need to be returned promptly after the performance.

Girls: Dancers need to come in **light pink ballet tights (clean without rips) and bring their ballet slippers.**

Pre-K students will dance in bare feet; girls' **tights need to be footless or convertible** (have a slit on the bottom so they can be rolled up around the ankle).

No undergarments for girls, including underwear or bras, should be worn underneath tights or costumes. Sometimes this is a hard concept; you can explain that costumes and leotards are to be worn similarly to swimsuits. This applies to in-class dress code as well.

The costumes have built-in support. However, if your dancer would feel more comfortable & benefit from additional support, they can wear a nude-colored bra.

Boys: All costume pieces will be supplied; no additional clothing or garments are needed. Pre-k dancers will be dancing in bare feet, dancers Kinder+ are asked to wear a black slipper.

Performance Schedule

Arrive 15 minutes before the listed performance time and report to the green room just north

of the main event hall. We will start right on time and cannot wait for late dancers.

All classes regularly scheduled before 4:00 PM will be performing on Saturday, May 13th; find your child's class & performance time listed under "Saturday".

All classes which are regularly scheduled after 4:00 PM, will be held the evening of their regularly scheduled class. Please find your dancer's class & performance time below.
